W H E R E A S :

A. The Settlor/Founder is desirous of creating a trust for the purpose of founding educational institution and

other ...



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other institutions for the education and training of boys, girls as well as adult in educative and vocational pursuits and for the development of character so as to produce law abiding, fearless and healthy citizens.

B. The Settlor/Founder has set apart a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) particularly described in the Schedule hereunder written (hereinafter referred to as the said Trust Fund) to form a Trust fund for the said trust.

C. The Trustees abovenamed are willing to be interested with the ownership of the Trust Fund for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Settlor/Founder under the direction set forth herein and to prosecute its objectives according to the directions and wishes of the Settlor/Founder.

D. The Trustees abovenamed have agreed to accept the said trust on the terms and conditions hereinafter appearing.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows :-

1. Name of the Trust :

The name of the Trust shall be MULTIPLE EDUCATIONAL AND EMPOWERMENT DEVELOPMENT TRUST, having its registered office at 13, Dum Dum Road, Calcutta-700074, City office at 32, Chittaranjan Avenue, Calcutta - 700012.

2. Vesting of the Trust Fund :

The Settlor/Founder as beneficial owner of the said Trust Fund conveys transfers grants and assigns unto the Trustees All that the said Trust Fund TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same in trust for the objects of the trusts set forth below to be used and appropriated by the trust to carry on and fulfil the object of the trust.

3. Object of the Trust :

The objects of the trust are :

- i) To open, run, continue educational and vocational schools or any other institutions or colleges in healthy and salubrious surrounding.
- ii) To engage teachers, professors, instructors and experts of good moral character and conduct able to impart efficiently and economically up-to-date instruction to pupils and students in modern Sciences, industrial avocations, research and development work, management including hospitality or otherwise intellectual and other useful pursuits incidental thereto.
- iii) To develop a healthy as well as critical attitude towards the development of mental, physical and moral upliftment of the students and all those connected with the institutions so as to make them good citizens.
- iv) To establish, maintain and run a boarding house and residential institution for the students and those connected with the institution.
- v) To invest, dispose of, transfer and otherwise deal with the subject matter of the trust in such manner as the trustees should deem fit as to enable the trust to carry on the objects of the trust effectively.
- vi) To accept donations, grants, presents, and other offerings and to deal with ~~as~~ the same for the purpose of the trust.

vii) ...

- vii) To charge tuition fees and otherwise recoup ~~has~~ themselves for the outlay and expenses incurred in the upkeep and maintenance of institutions established or about to be established under ~~has~~ the deed.
- viii) To train and equip the pupils so as to be self-supporting in an honourable and decent way of life so as to develop into good, healthy and progressive citizens.
- ix) To promote ~~has~~ and inculcate the dignity of labour, the appreciation of intellectual gifts and talents of all kinds.
- x) To encourage sportsman and adventurous spirit in the pupils and those connected with the institution and coming in contact with them and to participate in games of skill and prowess.
- xi) To develop disciplinary conduct and a habit to observe the rule of law and self-restraint.
- xii) To bring out, encourage and develop the inventive and research faculties of the pupils and teachers and to afford opportunity for research work in art, science and industrial undertakings.
- xiii) To run, develop and improve, extend workshops, industrial and technical school, agricultural institutions and farms, research and development works.
- xiv) To allow and pay stipends, scholarships.

xv) To acquire movable or immovable properties out of the Trust fund or from the income of the Trust and to dispose of the properties acquired to attain the object of the Trust.

xvi) To attain and carry out the objects of the Trusts by the Trustees who are vested with the powers incorporated herein.

4. Board of Trustees, its meetings etc :

i) The Trust shall be governed by a Board of Trustees which will ordinarily consist of not less than three and not more than nine members. The Trustees may co-opt to the Board of Trustees, if necessary, to make the total number to nine.

ii) The Trustees co-opted shall hold office only for three years and are liable for retirement. The Trustees whose term of office expires after the period of three years, are eligible to be co-opted as Trustees again by the existing Trustees. The Trustees may if he so desires resign from his Trusteeship even before the expiry of the term of his Trusteeship.

iii) The Trustees shall appoint one among them as Managing Trustee of the Board of Trustee.

iv) In the absence of the Managing Trustee at any meeting,

the ...

the Trustees present may elect one amongst themselves as Chairman of the Meeting.

- v) The Board of Trustees shall meet as often as necessary and their proceedings shall be recorded regularly in the Minutes Book to be retained ~~a~~ for the purpose. In any resolution ~~be~~ to be passed touching the administration of the Trust, the opinion of the majority shall prevail. It shall be competent however for the Trustees to decide matters by circulation.
- vi) In case of all policy decision in the meeting of the board of Trustees the decision of the majority of the Trustees present in the meeting shall prevail.
- vii) If the Trustees shall be divided in opinion, the matter shall be decided by the casting vote of the Managing Trustee or the Chairman.

5. Powers and duties of the Board of Trustees :

- i) The Trustees shall have power from time to time to increase or decrease the corpus of fixed property of the Trust Fund and this corpus will not be used in contravention of restriction mentioned hereinabove.
- ii) The Trustees shall have power to accept donations either in cash or moveable properties or immovable properties either with or without any special conditions

attached to it.

- iii) It shall be competent for the Trustees from time to time to frame, make and enforce all such rules, regulations and/or bye-laws not inconsistent with the express provisions of this trust as the Trustees may deem proper for securing and facilitating the administration and management in detail of the various departments relating to the activities and affairs of the trust, and for convening, conducting and regulating the meeting of the trustees and for appointing Sub-committee or Sub-committees and generally for the management and administration of the trust estate and also from time to time to repeal, alter, amend, rescind or add to all such rules, regulations and by laws and also to pass resolutions in connection with all or any of the said matter or matters at their meeting.
- iv) The trustees shall have power and authority to appoint or engage and at their discretion remove, dismiss or suspend one or more teachers, principal, vice-principal, advisers, administrator, secretaries, treasurers, supervisors, cashiers, accountants, clerks, snowkiders, attendants, servants, supervisors and other officials or employees and persons in permanent, temporary or special service inclusive professional persons in connection with the work of the trust trustestate,

trust ...

trust funds, and trust properties as they may from time to time think fit and to determine their powers, and duties and fix their salaries, bonus emoluments remuneration or fees and to require security in such instance and such amounts as the trustees may think fit. The Trustees shall also have power to found and maintain provident funds, gratuity funds, personal and other funds for any employee and make rules and regulations regarding the same.

v) The Trustees shall have power in general to acquire or to take or lease or otherwise or to dispose of or give or lease or otherwise or charge or mortgages all things both moveable and immovable belonging to the Trust and do all acts necessary to carry out the objects of the trust on such terms and conditions as the trustees may deem fit and proper.

vi) The Trustees shall be entitled to reimburse themselves out of the trust estate all expenses incurred in or about the execution of the trust or powers herein or in carrying out the trust, its objects and affairs or the realization, preservation or benefit of the trust properties. The trustees shall be entitled to be indemnified by ~~the~~ the trust properties, against the consequences of all lawful acts done by the trustees in the course of and discharge of their duties as the trustees of ~~the~~ these trusts and all costs, charges and expenses thereof.

vii) ..

- vii) The Managing Trustee shall be entitled to such monthly remuneration as may be decided by the Board of Trustees. The remaining members of the Board of Trustees may, if he/she or they desire and if approved by the Board of Trustees, be absorbed by the trust in its day to day activities at such remuneration as may be decided by the Board of Trustees. Save the Managing Trustee and the Trustee/s absorbed in the employment of the trust, other trustee/s shall be entitled to Rs. 500/- for attending the meeting of the trust and the expenses for attending the meeting.
- viii) The Trustees may at any time invite and receive or without such invitation receive any voluntary contribution or contributions either from the settlor or from the trustees or from any one or more of them or from any other person or persons by way of donation, legacy or otherwise. All such contributions shall be treated as forming part of the trust fund being the subject matter of these presents provided that it shall always be for the trustees in their absolute discretion to decide whether they should invite and/or accept any such contribution and they shall at all times be at liberty to refuse any contribution without giving any reason for such refusal.
- ix) The Trustees shall have power to deposit the trust moneys or any portion thereof in any nationalised bank

or banks either by way of fixed deposit or in current account or jointly by two trustees one of whom shall be the Managing Trustee.

- x) The Trustees shall also have power to invest the trust money in and Government securities or in any other approved manner and also to invest in such manner as may be directed by the Board of Trustees, and from time to time vary the investment in which the trustfunds may be invested.
- xi) The Trustee with the consent of Board of Trustees may invest the ~~xx~~ trust moneys with any private individuals or firm or association of persons or body of individuals.
- xii) For the purposes of carrying out of the objects of the trust, the trustees shall have power to acquire by purchase or on lease or otherwise any immovable or movable properties of any ^{tenure} and in case of vacant land the trustees shall be at liberty to erect buildings thereon and to do all acts necessary and incidental thereto.
- xiii) It shall be lawful for the trustees to pull down, renovate, rebuild, alter, adapt, improve, add to, develop or repair any immovable property comprised in the trust properties and to extend thereon such moneys out of the trustfund or the income thereof as they

may ...

may think fit and to appoint or dismiss or terminate the services of the persons appointed for such purpose and to pay their/his remuneration.

- xiv) The Trustees shall be entitled to enter into any agreements or covenants with the owners of or persons entitled to or interested in any other properties and to raise funds by way of loans.
- xv) It shall be lawful for the trustees at such time or times as they may in their absolute discretion think fit to sell by public auction or private contract or exchange or transfer or assign or grant leases or sub-leases for any term however long or otherwise dispose of all or any part of the trust properties including immovable properties.
- xvi) The Trustees may deposit for safe custody any documents held by them relating to any property belong to the trust under ~~has~~ these presents with any bank and may pay any sum payable in respect of the same.



The performance of the Fire Fighting System as incorporated in the buildings were tested at random and found satisfactorily working condition. In view of the above this office is releasing the Renewal of Fire Safety Certificate for occupancy of the aforesaid building.

However to up-keep the Fire Safety Measure of the aforesaid building the following safety measures need to be incorporated / maintained.

1. 1.Driveway must be free of any type of obstruction for EASY movement of Fire Appliances. No parking will be allowed on the Driveway.


